Day 0: Af-IX Day is...

- African IXP operators day
- Invite only event for IXP operators from African region (with a few exceptions)
- Aimed at addressing IXP specific issues
- Designed as a platform where in-depth technical discussions can take place
- Promote the growth of IXPs in the region.

Day 1: Peering Coordinators Day is...

- Conducted in tutorial style format and open to anyone interested in peering & interconnection
- Provide a technical background on peering and interconnection for newcomers
- Designed as a platform where in-depth technical discussions can take place
- Promote the role of peering coordinators in the region.

Day 2 & 3: AfPIF Conference Day

is...

- Conducted in plenary format and open to all
- Sessions are divided into
 - Keynote sessions with Q &A
 - Panel Sessions
 - Bilateral peering sessions
 - Lightning talks
- Less technical and involves more discussions on various issues affecting peering and interconnection
