

## **Memorandum of Understanding**

Between

New York Greater Metropolitan Area Chapter of the Internet Society (“ISOC-NY”)

and

Google

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) sets for the terms and understanding between ISOC-NY and Google, with Google join ISOC-NY as a Platinum Member.

### **Background**

ISOC-NY is a non-profit organization, trusted as the world’s independent source of leadership for Internet policy, technology standards, and future development, serving the Greater New York City community. We work to ensure the Internet continues to grow and evolve as a platform for innovation, economic development, and social progress for people around the world. Working on a Digital Preservation Campaign will help further our mission of ISOC-NY:

- 1 in support of ISOC, to assure the beneficial, open evolution of the global Internet,
- 2 to promote local initiatives, maximize the societal benefits which the Internet can bring to the New York area, and
- 3 to advance the professional development of ISOC members in the New York area.

### **Purpose**

Google’s Platinum Membership with ISOC-NY will have the following benefits:

- ISOC-NY will plan and host a series of Digital Preservation events in NYC
- ISOC-NY will coordinate with other ISOC North America chapters on possible joint hosting of Digital Preservation events
- Create and maintain the website for the Digital Preservation campaign, including domain name and site hosting
- Special recognition and acknowledgement of platinum support on ISOC-NY’s website and publications
- ISOC-NY Platinum Membership logo for use on your organization’s website and marketing materials
- Provide input into our general and educational programming

### **Funding**

Funds will come directly from Google’s annual Platinum Membership dues to ISOC-NY in the amount of \$20,000.

**Duration**

This MOU is at-will and may be modified by mutual consent of authorized officials from ISOC-NY and Google. This MOU shall become effective upon signature by the authorized officials from the ISOC-NY and Google and will remain in effect until modified or terminated by any one of the partners by mutual consent. In the absence of mutual agreement by the authorized officials from ISOC-NY and Google this MOU shall end one year after signing.
